Can you believe we are wrapping up another wonderful season at Lake Bonnet?! This is the last Chatter of 2018-2019 and your BOD wish each of you a happy and healthy summer. We look forward to welcoming everyone back in the fall/winter of 2019. We wish our full-time residents a happy and healthy summer. We would like to thank you in advance for 'holding down the fort'. We hope you don't have to take cover in Lake Bonnet Hall, but we all feel better knowing it is there for your safety. A hurricane or tornado is always a possibility in Florida. Remember as you pack to leave that ALL water to your unit turned off and ANY objects that could become flying debris in a storm is placed inside.

Be very careful to inquire about rates when requesting RV work by any local companies. A camper was charged \$446 for a repair call even though nothing was found to be wrong with the motor home. The technician was here for about an hour. Our office has informed this RV repair company that they are not to return to this park in the future.

The canal seawall permit was issued by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection on March 15. A copy of the DEP permit from the state must be a part of your application with the Highlands County Building Department. The County requires that the DEP will need to sign off BEFORE the County will issue any seawall building permits. The County will charge a building permit fee. LBV must provide each applicant with a statement of authorization from the co-op or the County will not issue the permit. It is suggested you check with LBV office to

be sure everything you require is in hand before going to the County for the permit. A copy of your County permit is required by LBV office to be kept on file.

Again, your BOD is asking you to not park ANY possessions on ANY lot you are not paying rent for. You will be charged accordingly and asked to remove your possessions.
