Friendly Reminders:

- *Quiet Hours* in our park are from 10:00 pm until 8:00 am.
- *Pool hours* are posted at both pools. These hours are an insurance requirement. We appreciate your compliance.
- *Vaping* is not allowed at any of the park buildings or at the pools.
- *NO mattresses or furniture* are to be placed in our dumpsters or at the "exchange mall". Please inform anyone who delivers a new mattress, furniture or appliance to your home that they are NOT ALLOWED to place the old items in our dumpsters or dumpster area on their way out. They must be removed from the park. If you see or are aware of anyone placing mattresses in our dumpsters, please let the office know. Recently 4 people had to climb into the dumpster to remove a mattress. Mattresses, large appliances and furniture left at the exchange mall cost the Co-op (you) money to be removed.
- *Defibrillators* (heart resuscitation devices) are in both clubhouses and in the entrance to the office building. There is no training needed to use these life saving devices. The directions are given orally by the machine when the device is activated. You may want to check them out when you are in the clubhouse. Please don't activate them until an actual emergency.
- *Mis-delivered mail* may occasionally show up in your mailbox. If it is addressed to someone in our park, please hand deliver it to them rather than put it in the outgoing mailbox. The Post Office *will not* attempt to deliver it again, which may cause problems for the original recipient if it is a bill or financial document. Please take the time to help another member of the park out by delivering it to them. Thank you.
