Felt a need to bring the following to your attention as we all tend to have "senior moments".

1. During the summer when site changes are requested, the resident completes the necessary paper requirements and submits it to a Director here in the Park for approval. There will be times when this is not possible as Directors will be absent due to personal circumstances. Site changes require Board approval.

2. To rent or loan your unit or lot, the Park requires a rental application to be turned in for approval. This rental agreement requires a fee to be paid by the owner. Additional fees will be required if additional visitors stay at the unit.
