The residents of LBV who remain thru-out the summer season will start to see the "snow birds" returning. Again, the LBV Board of Directors welcome any and all ideas that can and will continue to make our village a great place to live.

Significant improvements to our Park have been completed during the summer season. Notably, the pools, hot tub, fencing along the entry as well as the Treatment Plant. An additional lift station has been installed to prevent sewer problems along Canal and Sandy Beach Rd. Additional electric updates have been completed between Driftwood and Redwood.

Also, some palm trees along Lake Bonnet Road and at the Sandy Beach Pool have been replaced. Our waste water treatment plant as well as the fresh water drinking water, both of these systems have been tested, approved and all permits issued.

The next LBV Board meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 17th. Plan to attend as the Board would like your input as to what your concerns are.

One of the biggest concerns the Board will be working on starting in October will be the budget for 2012.
